Year 1 & 2 - 10 - 15 minutes daily reading and 45 minutes - 1 hour of other homework that may include weekly spellings, Talk Homework and occasional other homework.


Year 3 & 4 - 10 - 15 minutes daily reading and 1 - 1.5 hours of other homework per week

Year 5 & 6 - 10 - 15 minutes daily reading and 1.5 - 2.5 hours of other homework per week
